Gospel Outreach Around the World

Winning Souls in a Uganda Village

Hellen, an iTEE University student pursuing the Diploma in Ministry, grew up in the war-torn districts of northern Uganda. This region has endured civil war for several decades. Before encountering Christ, Hellen lived in constant fear, but her new faith began transforming her.

Invited by her friend, Mary Hope, Hellen joined an outreach team. They preached on the streets, door-to-door, and visited hospitals and prisons. At church, Hellen led women and youth ministries. In 2021 when visiting her brother, she discovered much darkness. Villagers were in poverty and enslaved by prostitution, alcoholism, and witchcraft.

The Holy Spirit brought about conviction to Hellen and caused her to enter into a very personal discussion with God. "Hellen, I want you to go and

reach your village with the Gospel." But LORD, how will I find the resources to pay for the effort to reach my village?"

After much prayer and by putting into practice what she was learning from iTEE University, Hellen organized a crusade. She took her month salary of \$800 to cover expenses, and she coordinated efforts with a local pastor to lead the crusade in late 2023. By day, she organized and her team made home visits. By night, they preached and ministered to the people under a large tent. They counted 82 salvations, and many villagers were delivered from alcoholism and demonic oppression.

The Bible says in Matthew 24:14,

"And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come."

This is what iTEE Global students are doing in over 50 nations of the world where iTEE University is training leaders. They are bringing the Gospel to Africa, Asia, Europe, South, Central America, and North America.

Evangelism Activities in DR Congo



Dr. Daniel Kyungu Tchikala recently joined iTEE Global. He is a social scientist and the Senior Pastor of Africa Inland Church Congo in Lubumbashi.

The workers in the Evangelism Department preach, teach, and conduct Bible studies. They organize door-to-door evangelism, open-air campaigns, hospitals, and prison visits to share the Gospel.

These activities require training, sound equipment, transportation for evangelization in remote areas, and other resources for effective evangelism.

The church has a network of a hundred public schools that will be a great platform for evangelism. They are training responsible workers to collaborate with the teachers to evangelize in these schools.

Evangelism in Guatemala

Teddy Torres is the Latin America Ministry Director of iTEE Global and a course Facilitator.

He coordinates evangelism with other faith organizations using a variety of strategies.



He gives two great examples: 1) Entrepreneurial training for new businesses is a 4-month training to share the message of Jesus and entrepreneurship principles to all participants. During the training, he shares testimonies about successful Christian community transformation through business endeavors.

2) Juvenile Jail Ministry where he goes with a friend to share the Gospel, at least once a month to the young people.

They also bring them personal hygiene items, encourage them, and pray with them. At times they do follow-up where they help them to get out of jail, find a job, and start a new life. They contact their parents, and friends, and coordinate with the judicial system for their release.

Evangelism in India



Cynthia, a student of iTEE University invited Sunil, a colleague among youth group leaders, to the Galatians course.

It was Sunil's first encounter with Jesus Christ where he realized that he was saved by grace, through faith, and not by his works.

Through this truth, the Holy Spirit stirred his heart to start his own Bible study group in 2016.

After Cynthia and Sunil discipled a group of 29 leaders, their small group exploded. They actively shared the Gospel in their city Chennai, India with college students, served homebound seniors, and creatively hosted dramatic Gospel presentations on the life of Jesus at Easter and Christmas. Now nine years later, they have shared the gospel with more than 3,000 young people and they are currently discipling over 300 youth and teens.

As an extension of this discipleship-making movement, Sunil, Cynthia, and their team opened a computer gaming center for young people. It is called "The 360" and is in the vicinity of three colleges. It appeals to young people and is a great opportunity to engage them with the gospel.

Trained volunteers at the center talk, pray, and counsel the young people who come to the center. Many young people are coming to Christ through this outreach.

Sunil's prayer is that God would transform the lives of many people.

Evangelism In Zambia

Fegas Kaumba is the National Director of iTEE Global in Zambia. Every week, he gathers children in his community to share the Gospel, to teach the Bible, and pray for them.



In Zambia there are many opportunities to share the Gospel in crusades, door-to-door, and one-on-one.

Recently ministries have incorporated evangelism with other activities, like sport and games evangelism, when a game is organized in the community to preach the Gospel to the players and the audience. Another opportunity for evangelism is the sharing of meager resources with those in desperate need. A church team distributes several items to the families and shares the Gospel.

Evangelism One-on-One



Peter, from India, is a member of iTEE Global. Recently he took the Galatians course and shared with SK the doctrine of "Salvation by grace through faith" and the concept of "Righteousness in Christianity". SK is a Hindu

and of the Vaishnavites caste that worships "Vishnu". They believe that their gods will come to destroy sinners. SK's perfect role model is Mahatma Gandhi. He always thought Christianity was a religion that allowed people to act any way they want to live. He met "Christians" who drink in excess, live immorally, and are dishonest in business dealings. They told him that they could confess to God or the priest anytime,

and everything would be taken care of.

Peter showed him through the scriptures that life is in Jesus. SK now understands the Christian faith better and the importance of the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. He still believes that he must do good works for the rest of his life to be "one" with the deity. He has not decided about Christ yet. Please pray that SK will follow Jesus.
