## iTEE Global is Impacting Africa

### Global Insights Article Impacts Pastor Francis Macauley and Sierra Leone



Pastor Francis Macauley is the lead pastor of the Amazing Revival of Evangelism Movement in Sierra Leone, whose mission is to win people to Christ, train believers to become disciples and send disciples to impact the world.

Pastor Francis started studying with iTEE University online in 2021, has completed over 20 courses, and currently serves as a co-facilitator and face-to-face trainer.

Pastor Francis on Zoom to plan a mission trip to his village and a building project for his ministry. They subsequently shipped a container with construction tools, basketball kits, soccer kits, and two video projectors.

In November 2023, seven church members arrived in Freetown to rebuild Pastor Francis' church into a stable cement block structure, replacing the previous zinc structure. They also gathered hundreds of local children to play soccer, and gave them soccer equipment such as shoes, jerseys, and socks. They visited two schools, teaching around 200 children about God. Since then, his church has continued to grow.

**Francis's own life story is one of amazing grace. He grew up in a Muslim family that was connected to witch doctors. But Francis was drawn to Christian churches. As a child, he would go to the mosque and attend church services. He became very interested to know. On March 27, 2010, he encountered the Lord's clear message of hope while at an outdoor revival. He then gave his life to Christ. He was with his friends. They were baptized and received Bibles. And his life was never the same.**

**In 2012, Francis began teaching Sunday School. With the help of a friend, he attended Bible College in Freetown, the capital city, and graduated with a diploma in Theology. More doors were opening for ministry. He was asked to teach a Bible study at one village when one of his friends declined the request and passed it on to him. Francis stepped in and started the Evangelism Movement. It was a self-funded endeavor. Soon another village was added on his map for ministry. Then he got involved in many more villages.**

**In 2016, Francis made a list of 199 remote villages where he wanted to preach the gospel, strengthen established churches, and plant new churches. In the years that followed, he succeeded only being able to reach 69 of these villages. He continues to pursue the 199 villages to this day.**

In March 2023, Global Insight featured a story on Pastor Francis and how he had a goal to reach 199 of Sierra Leone's remotest villages with the Gospel. At that time, he and his team had traveled to 69 villages to make disciples. They have now reached 90 villages and are still advancing on their goal!



The team also conducted a three-day pastoral and leadership training with local pastors. One of Francis' long-term goals is to train pastors in every area of Sierra Leone to make disciples and even to minister in other countries.

In 2023, Pastor Francis started a face-to-face teaching class at his local church, which included iTEE University courses. His church members have completed three courses: *Galatians*, *Romans* and *The Christian Life*. Pastor Francis says, "Since I started these classes, lives are being transformed. Many of

The article in Global Insight caught the attention of a large church in Pennsylvania, who wanted to partner with Pastor Francis' efforts. First, the church shipped 18 bicycles, which he distributed among pastors in Sierra Leone. These bicycles allowed the pastors to travel to other villages to spread the Gospel and do visitation. The church began meeting with

those involved in these classes are now main workers in the church, with much biblical foundation. We have a women's leader assisting my wife, Sunday school teachers, and children's teachers. They have volunteered to help impact lives in the church and community. Most of the Jesus Film outreaches we do in the local communities every Wednesday are now done without me. We are planning to open a branch church in the second capital city in Sierra Leone, Bo District, and some are willing to go there. We are trusting the Lord to open the doors for us. And even here, we trust the Lord to start another church in Freetown. A lot of transformation has happened since I started this face-to-face teaching, a lot of boldness and determination."

The teachings of iTEE Global, one article in Global Insight, and the generosity and initiative of one church have changed many lives forever in Sierra Leone.

## Cyrus Nuseta of Juja, Kenya

Cyrus Nuseta is a delightful, engaging young man. He



got involved with iTEE Global through Reverend Solomon, pastor of Outpost Pentecostal Church in Juja, Kenya, along with sixteen other students in the Juja cohort. Cyrus had only been a church member for two months when Pastor Solomon suggested he take iTEE training.

Cyrus has natural leadership qualities, and his classmates look up to him because he does everything with zeal.

Cyrus says the iTEE Global course that impacted him the most was *The Christian Life*, because it taught him the standards a believer should live by. It helped him grow in his relationship with Jesus Christ. Cyrus plans to share the Gospel of Christ through discipleship and servanthood with everyone around him. He has been growing disciples through ministry engagements like Bible study, mentoring, and church leadership.

Cyrus has struggled with self-esteem issues since high school and throughout his studies at Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and Technology. (In June, he will graduate with a bachelor's degree in business and finance). Recently, while teaching a Bible study, he had a strong sense of the Holy Spirit's filling him and giving him power to minister. He believes the teachings of iTEE Global helped to give him the courage and confidence to teach a Bible



study, and that the Lord empowered him to do even more because he stepped out to minister.

On April 10, 2025, Cyrus, along with most of the members of his cohort, graduated with a Diploma in Ministry from iTEE University.

## John Sakala – Kasenengwa District, Zambia – Making Disciple-Makers



"Making Disciple-Makers" is not just a tagline for iTEE Global; it is a vision for executing the Great Commission. One of our Zambian students, Pastor John Sakala, embodies this vision in his ministry.

A full-time pastor in the Kasenengwa District in eastern Zambia, Pastor John lives with his wife, Maggie Mbao, and five children. When he's not involved in ministry work, he is growing food such as maize, sunflowers, and soybeans.

In 2018, when Pastor John was studying at a Bible school in Lusaka, Zambia, he heard about iTEE University from his bishop. He then connected with iTEE's Country Director, Fegas Kaumba, and registered for his first course. Pastor John has since taken 16 iTEE University online courses, which have equipped him with knowledge and skills that have improved his ministry. Through his studies and his interactions with iTEE University's online facilitators, Pastor John caught the vision for making disciple-makers for Christ. He stated, "...without iTEE Global, I couldn't have known what making disciples is and how it could be done!"

John teaches two large groups of disciples (40 people total) in the Chipata, Zambia area. They meet once per week for 3-4 hours each time. One group is part of

his own church, the Faith Tabernacle Believers Church in the Chiparamba village, while the other group is in Anderson Village. Both groups are studying the iTEE **One-to-One** course, translated into the Chichewa language. The **One-to-One** course helps believers develop a deeper relationship with God through spiritual disciplines and challenges students to share their learning “one on one” with others outside the class. John’s wife Maggie helps him teach this course to the believers.

Last fall, Pastor John shared a bold vision with his online classmates. His goal for 2025 would be to make ten new disciple-makers, who would make one disciple each. Through *The Christian Life* course, he realized how investing in good relationships was critical to reaching his goal. He chose his 10 disciple-makers prayerfully and carefully, having observed their previous commitments to the Lord.

John has already made progress this year. Together, he and his disciple-makers have finished *Galatians* and the **One-to-One** course. John meets with each man weekly to pray and encourage him as they study scripture together. While poverty limits many people in their area from personally owning a Bible. John has ensured that each of his disciple-makers owns one. He shares about the struggles they face as they grow more mature in following Jesus and making disciples:

“I encourage them, saying God’s work isn’t without challenges, but the best we can do is to soldier on until the last breath of our life!”



Dave Andrews brings a unique blend of warmth, humor, and faithfulness to his role as Dean of Students with iTEE University. Since 2020, Dave has been a vital part of iTEE’s Administrative staff. Some of Dave’s duties are helping to register students, assisting students who are

having technical difficulties logging into classes, and conducting student orientation. Dave’s heart for people shines through in every interaction, making him a steady and compassionate presence within the iTEE Global family.

Dave’s journey of faith began early. Raised in a loving Christian home, he jokes that his salvation experience came with an added bonus—his mother led him to the Lord while giving him a bath, which made the “baptism” convenient! That moment, however lightheartedly remembered, marked the beginning of a life anchored in God’s grace and purpose.

Dave met his wife at a high-school church camp, and after seven years of courtship, they were married. Now, with 38 years of marriage behind them, they are proud parents of two grown sons (ages 35 and 32) and joyful grandparents to a grandson (age 5) and granddaughter (age 3). Though physical distance keeps them apart, Dave is grateful for technology like FaceTime that keeps family connections strong.
