We also have students from the United States. iTEE Global's emphasis on interactive learning using questions, small groups, and discussions usually resonates better with younger people than one-way communication.



The UK student said, "These learnings with other principles regarding biblical interpretation taught in the course have significantly shifted my understanding of the Bible and enhanced my curiosity about knowing God more. It exposed that my experience of reading and understanding

the Word of God was limited and random, often undermining the role of the Holy Spirit in guiding me to the truth and myself seeking answers and meanings to some of the difficult passages or relying on what others say. Also, I had a presumption that biblical interpretation is more of a denominational issue that doesn't affect individual believers' faith, attitude, or way of life, which was very wrong.

Moving forward, I commit myself, with the Holy Spirit, to seeking the true meaning of the Word of God through committing to careful interpretation to grow and get the wisdom to lead my life and help others see their true Savior, Christ."

A student in North America said, "iTEE Global has helped me to be better equipped to share my faith with others and has helped me make disciples. It has taught me how to have better conversations with the people I work with who have no faith background."

Preparing to Present Christ in Greece



Greece has been a haven for migrants trying to find a better life. In Athens, a group of South Asian Christian migrants are working at local restaurants, trying to make a better life for themselves. They don't know Greek and have limited English, so finding a place to worship in a country becoming more secularized is difficult. They began meeting as a group, trying to keep their focus on Jesus despite their trials in making a new life.

One man in the group committed himself to help the others grow spiritually, and wanted to learn how to be a better Christian leader. He contacted iTEE Global for help. Unfortunately, the long hours and hectic schedule of the restaurant restricted his ability to take courses. Nevertheless, one of our facilitators has been providing him with materials in his native language, and teaching him slowly one-on-one. Serving with iTEE Global



Tim McGrath and his wife, Rhonda, have shared 31 beautiful years of marriage and currently call Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, home. After moving from California in 2017 to be closer to family, Tim found himself in

a season of seeking God, asking what was next. That search led him to iTEE Global, and what started as a quiet nudge soon became a clear calling.

For years, God had been nurturing in Tim a deep love for mentoring, training, and missions. With a degree in Mechanical Engineering, Tim spent much of his career traveling across Latin America and Europe—training others in medical device manufacturing and professional development. Even then, he was unknowingly being prepared for a different kind of teaching: one with an eternal impact.

Tim's heart for ministry was already evident through years of serving in children's Sunday school, joining mission trips to Kenya and Haiti, completing the Kairos missions course, and helping guide his church's global outreach as part of the missions administrative team.

In 2018, Tim officially stepped into ministry with iTEE Global. What excited him most was the opportunity to merge his passions—to mentor, teach, and walk alongside emerging Christian leaders across the globe through iTEE University's online courses. He quickly found joy and purpose as a course facilitator, discovering that even through a screen, powerful transformation could take place.

One course in particular, *Spiritual Leadership*, left a lasting impact. As both a student and facilitator, Tim began to see how God was shaping him personally—not just as a teacher, but as a servant-leader. That same year, he was invited to serve as an elder at Thrive Church, his home church in Fond du Lac. Though hesitant at first, Tim leaned into God's strength and the skills he was developing through iTEE—learning to shepherd with humility, delegate wisely, and raise up new leaders.

In 2021, when the church's elder board was nearly empty, Tim partnered with his pastor to rebuild a strong foundation of leadership. His experience with iTEE also inspired him to write a Bible study course to help others grow in their understanding and love for Scripture.

In May 2024, Tim made a bold and faithful step by leaving his engineering career to fully dedicate himself to God's work through iTEE Global. Today, he continues to thrive in his role, finding deep joy in encouraging students, supporting them through challenges, and helping them discover their potential in Christ.

Tim has also helped with iTEE Global's Nehemiah Projects in Ghana and Pakistan, supported curriculum development, and is now working to strengthen student retention by helping build iTEE's academic advising and mentoring resources. Outside of ministry, Tim devotes time to caring for his aging father—reflecting his heart to serve wherever God leads.

Tim often says he's received far more than he's given—being equipped, mentored, and inspired by the incredible team at iTEE Global.
