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## Update on the Spanish-Speaking Ministry

iTEE Global has been working in Mexico, Cuba, Guatemala, and other Spanish-speaking countries for several years now. Here are a few student testimonies of how iTEE Global is impacting lives. (Last names have been omitted to protect their privacy).

### Francisco

Francisco's testimony includes long walks through the Sonoran Desert. He made that journey three times, leaving El Salvador with dreams and a bottle of water in his backpack. As he crossed

the great border, he felt God wanted to tell him something, but he didn't understand what it was. After several attempts, he gave up and got a job in his country: building houses, mixing mortar, and levelling bricks.

Francisco, also called Paco, discovered iTEE University a couple of years ago and



is nearing completion of the Certificate in Biblical Studies program. He was recently hired by his local church as a youth group counsellor for the community development project in Ahuachapán. Today, Paco says that, thanks to his Bible studies, he can counsel the youth in his community and has begun to discover that God wants him “to build with the Word of God, the guidance of the Spirit, and a learning community.”

## Graciela



Graciela Elizabeth was born in Mexico City, but now, at twenty-five years old, she resides in the city of León, in the state of Guanajuato, Mexico. She lives with her parents, who are pastors of a small church, and they introduced her to iTEE Global’s *Galatians* course.

She actively supports several ministries within the church, particularly the worship ministry and the church’s fundraising efforts. Since early childhood, missions has been her passion, and the Lord has stirred in her the drive to be an avid supporter of such work. This includes contributing financially to missionaries, praying for them regularly, and, when the opportunity arises, traveling with others to preach the gospel.

Graciela sometimes struggles to find confidence in what to say, fearing that she might mislead others. Her learning with iTEE University has equipped her with the courage she needs to speak boldly in the church and at youth groups.

We look forward to seeing what God will do in her life as she continues to learn with iTEE University.

## Claudia

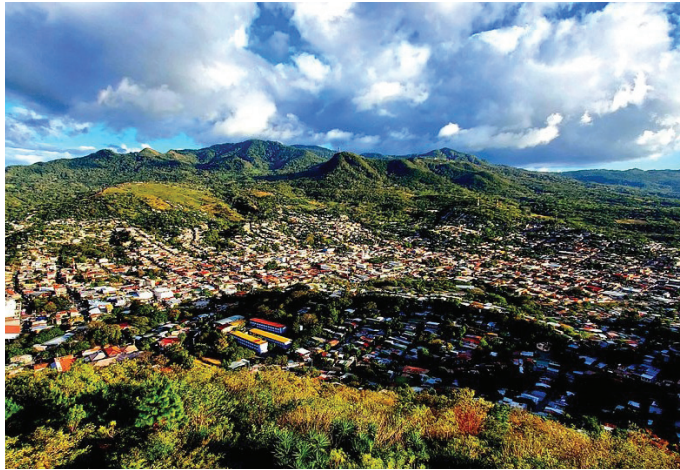
Claudia, 34, currently lives in central Nicaragua with her husband Edison and their three-year-old daughter. To support themselves, they grow basic grains and primarily coffee, but they have hearts for ministry. For several years, they served as youth pastors and led home Bible study meetings. Recently, they joined an Assemblies’ of God church in their hometown and are completing the new members process while continuing to share the Gospel with their neighbors.



One of their friends informed them about iTEE University. Claudia enrolled because of the sound biblical classes where she could study the Bible in depth. She also appreciates the translation of many courses into Spanish, enabling her to study in her own language. Claudia is grateful that iTEE’s courses are not simply independent studies which she would need to complete on her own. Rather, they include live facilitators who are available to answer questions and provide the needed encouragement to study and complete the program.

The *Galatians* course challenged Claudia in her faith, her understanding of grace, the foundation of salvation, the freedom in Christ, and the guidance of the Holy Spirit. She came to understand how the biblical message of grace

challenges our “normal” ways of thinking about religious rules and what it means to please God. Her trust in God has grown and she rejoices in the freedom God provides through salvation.



## Evangelism in Guatemala

Worldwide, an estimated 120 million Anglicans are represented in the Anglican Communion of Churches. The Anglican Episcopal Church in Guatemala is a historic and diverse denomination in that country. Currently, there are 38 Anglican churches and mission centers in Guatemala, located in 13 departments.



In these churches, evangelism often happens in Sunday school, making it a vital program where teachers need training. Earlier this year, iTEE trained two Anglican churches using its intensive course *Excellence in Interactive Teaching*. One of the participants remarked that “Sunday school is more effective when there is more participation from the children. We were able to hear their voices, get to know their hearts and present Jesus to them. Now we have more teachers to continue teaching each week.”

## Profile of a Missionary: In Memory of Pedro Razo



Two years ago, the iTEE Global community was deeply shaken by the news that our beloved friend and colleague, Pedro Razo, unexpectedly passed away on February 14, 2023. Pedro had attended the annual staff conference in October 2022. During the conference, he was excited about the Spanish-speaking ministry he was leading in Mexico and Cuba, and eagerly spoke with staff to make further connections in these countries.



Pedro was a loving, tender-hearted, and giving man who demonstrated Christ-like character. Because of his great love for others, he was like a father figure to many of our students. With his passing, many of the Spanish-speaking students suddenly stopped communicating in the online classrooms, as they mourned his loss. Pedro’s wife Gabby, who worked alongside him as a facilitator, also needed to pause and take time to grieve.



Teddy Torres, who had been leading iTEE’s work in Guatemala, was suddenly thrust into the role of overseeing the entire Spanish-speaking ministry. This was a heavy load to bear while he also grieved the loss of Pedro.

Since then, it has taken time to rebuild and develop the Spanish-speaking ministry. However, with Teddy's guidance, the work has continued to grow and is now thriving. Translation of iTEE's materials into Spanish has been very successful, and a number of courses have been completed. We now need to finish translating the rest of the set of Spanish courses.

iTEE also needs more facilitators to help reach the 600 million Spanish-speaking people in the world. The potential for growth in multiple countries is immense and increasing quickly.

There are cultural and theological strongholds in the Spanish-speaking world that strongly emphasize good works as a means to salvation. Please pray that many believers will understand and embrace the grace emphasized in the book of Galatians.
